DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would convict and save any deceived, unregenerate church members, who attend church, but have never repented of sin and believed in Jesus for salvation.

WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

Focus your prayer around: **Romans 1:16** “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.”

Pray: Father, Your gospel is the good news about Your Son, Jesus Christ. It is the glorious and gracious message that through His Person and His work, sinners can be brought into a right relationship with You. It is the power of God to salvation. It is the message that brings sinners into a right relationship to You. It is the greatest message ever given among people. Yet, we are not sharing this message. We have grown indifferent to this message. We have failed to proclaim this message on a continual basis to the lost who are in desperate need of it. Forgive us of this abominable sin! Have mercy on us, O God! Grant revival to us that we would share this message with the lost. Send genuine revival so that Your gospel will go forth in power from us! For the sake of Your gospel, I plead that You will grant revival.

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for Biblical churches to focus on the great commission rather than politics and cultural concerns.

- Pray for God's people to hunger for God's Word and yearn to trust and obey God.
- Pray for God's people to see everyone as either lost or saved and on their way to heaven or hell. Pray God's people do everything possible to lead lost, hell-bound souls to saving faith and eternal hope.
- Pray for leaders to rise up and lead churches in the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to convict lost, hell-bound souls to repent and believe the Gospel.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to convict God's people to live on mission for Jesus, as He commanded.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Ask God to give LH and her members a clear vision and overwhelming passion to make disciples.

- Pray that God will move on us with the power of the Spirit so that we hate our sin and desire to be holy as He is holy.
- Pray for LH to believe in the truth of God's Word and be compelled to pursue lost sinners with the Gospel and to recover struggling saints who have lost their love for Jesus.
- Pray for LH members to pray for and seek to make disciples of people they know who are not alive in Christ Jesus through faith in Him.
- Pray for LH make more disciples of hundreds of people through worship, our groups: college, next generation, young adults, senior adults, and through our families.

SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gathering

Title: God Strengthens Saints | Text: Ephesians 4:11-16

Main Thrust: God has blessed His churches to provide what is needed to shepherd the people and equip them to do the work God calls and strengthens them to do.
