Rooted

Rooted is our gateway course for all disciples. It is a 11-week discipleship experience that provides you the opportunity to connect with God, the church family, and your purpose in unexpected, lifechanging ways. *Rooted* helps people of every life-stage, no matter where you are on your journey with Christ, to consider and practice the foundational elements of life in the way of Jesus. It all occurs in a small group environment that is marked by compelling conversations, story-telling, a safe space for questions, and practical learning experiences.

Resource cost: \$10 for Rooted manual / journal



Living Hope's Equip Core Courses are the foundational training for living the Disciple's Life. It is crucial that every disciple of Jesus be equipped with Biblical and practical training in 4 key areas: Christian Story, Christian Belief, Christian Formation, and Christian Witness. These courses are built around robust Bible study, exploration, discussion, and learning. They are designed to help disciples own their faith convictions and live them out with stronger thinking about the Word of God, deeper affection for Jesus, and more sensitivity to the Spirit. Our goal is to have every Living Hope disciple complete *Rooted* and all five core courses.
