## April 26-May 1, 2021

### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that we would be willing to speak God's Word to the people in our life and that God would supply opportunities to do so. You shall teach [God's commandments] diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. — Deut. 6:7

### MONDAY: Global Impact Partners: Reyn & Audrey

- We are expecting baby girl #2 in under a month now. May 17th is her due date, so that is a big point of prayer. We also NEED to stay healthy. Getting COVID prior to delivery would be terrible due to protocols at the hospitals here. It would be detrimental. So we need to try to engage with people in ministry safely without putting Audrey in danger. That will be tricky.
- We are also hoping to launch our media ministry in the coming 2 months. We need our NPs to cooperate for this to go smoothly. They are crucial to our success. We are also doing a vision-casting call for locals around Greece that might be interested in joining us for this ministry. Ask that we grow our team through this, and we are patient and persistent in training new disciple-makers.
- Finally, we think the country is on the cusp of reducing some restrictions - especially when it comes to foreign visitors. This will make it so much easier to get teams, volunteers, and interns here. However, there is not as much hope for the opening of businesses, restaurants, and schools, so they might remain locked down. This makes ministry difficult for us, and anyone who comes to join us as volunteers. We do hope to find a ministry center building for outreach soon. Pray that we find that perfect place to invest in a specific community. This would provide a lot more options for visitors to join in our ministry also.

### TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for all who come to the Centers for Hope who are in need. Pray they will see that the trials in their lives are designed to produce spiritual maturity and should be counted as joy. "Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing." **James 1:2-4**

### WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

**Focus your prayer around: Jeremiah 33:3** Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.

*Pray: Father, You have declared in Your Word that if I call to You that You will show me great and mighty things which I do not know. I am calling to You, O God! I am pleading with You to grant revival to the believers of Living Hope. We desperately need it. You have the power to grant it. I am calling on You and am believing You for this. This is Your Word. I am calling to You, Father. Will You be true to Your Word? Are you going to be faithful to Your promise Father? For the sake of Your Word, I plead that You will grant revival to Your people.*

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for Living Hope members graduating from college and heading into a new world.

- Pray for Living Hope to remain focused on the glory of God and the mission that Jesus has sent us on to make disciples and not on our preferences or opinions as it relates to COVID protocols.

### SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gatherings

Pray God will bless us as we continue our series: **Thriving with Truth**

Our focus: *A Thriving Life Affirms the Truth about Salvation*

/ **Text:** Ephesians 1:3-14 (*John 3:16-18; Rom. 5:6-8; 2 Cor.*

*4:4-6, 5:18-21*)

**Main Thrust:** The sinner's only hope for eternal salvation rests in the active, redeeming love of the Triune God, and the only right response to it is eternal gratitude and praise.

- *Challenge people* to be obedient to share the gospel with spiritually lost people, since that is the means God has chosen to bring sinners to salvation

- Encourage people to repent of sin and trust Christ alone for their eternal salvation.
- Teach people that salvation is purposed by God the Father, accomplished by God the Son, and applied by God the Holy Spirit.
- Help people to never get over or grow dull to the wonder and extent of their salvation: past forgiven, present empowered, future secured.
