*June 16, Wednesday, **Glendale, Ky, Lunch & Shopping***

Meet in the parking lot, near the student center, for a **10 am. departure.** Reservations have been made at Tony York's on Main for a 12:30 pm (EST) luncheon. Lunch will be a salad, choice of three entrees (country ham, meatloaf, or fried chicken), plus dessert and your choice of drink. **The cost will be \$20.00 (which also includes your tip).** After lunch you will have a couple of hours to visit the many antique malls, shops and boutiques.
