This week's sermon: Exalting God Even When We Doubt | Text: Malachi 1:11-14

Main Thrust: We all get lax in our attitude and affections toward God. These notions and feelings cause us to doubt the greatness of God. To overcome this doubt, we must choose to exalt God and regain our vision of how great He is.

- Challenge people to see and fear the power and greatness of God.

- Help people see the need to exalt God in order to overcome our doubt of God.
