### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that our city and nation would abandon secularism and other false religions and worship the one true God.

### MONDAY: Global Impact: Trey & Bellamy

### TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

### WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Continue to pray for God to open hearts and minds in Bowling Green to the healing power of the Gospel.

- Pray for those struggling with stress and anxiety to trust in Christ.
- Pray for those who provided care during the tornado and clean up who are struggling mentally and emotionally to trust Christ.
- Pray for children and their teachers that are struggling to trust in Christ.
- Pray for Christians in our city to share their hope in Christ.

### FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for Living Hope as we go out into the community to provide care to our city.

- Pray for a large number of people to go door to door and check on people needing help in our city.
- Pray for those needing help to connect with the resources we are able to provide.
- Pray for the people of LH who go out to connect with and develop life-long friendships with those who are in need and help them.
- Pray for God to be glorified and lives to be changed in this difficult time in our city.

### SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gatherings tomorrow.

We continue our series: **The Prayer of the Kingdom of God**

**Title: Praying for the Kingdom Needs | Text: Matthew 6:11**

**Main Thrust:** The prayers of the citizens of the Kingdom of God will be for God's glory, for the good of the person praying, and those being prayed for. God delights to provide for His people and has determined to do so through the faithful, humble prayers of His people (**Jms.4:1-3**).

- Challenge people to trust God for what is needed for His will to be accomplished.
- Encourage people to pray for the needs of themselves, their church, and the world and to seek the welfare of the city where God calls them to live in exile as ambassadors of the Kingdom of God (**Jer.29**).
- Teach people how God provided for the daily needs of Israel as they journeyed to the promise land and how He has promised to be with us, guide us, and provide for us on our journey to heaven.
- Help people understand that God already knows our needs (**Mt.6:8**). He wants us to pray specifically and with time-based requests so that He receives the glory for the provision and blessings He provides.
