### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that Living Hope would contend for the faith so that our hope may be proclaimed with clarity to our homes, our neighbors, and every generation in our city.

### MONDAY: Global Impact: Mark and Parker

### WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

Plead with God to grant the believers a hunger for the Word of God and a readiness to obey the Word of God (**Psalm 119:97, 103; 1 John 2:3-6**). Plead with the Holy Spirit to stir within every believer a desire to search and to know the Word of God. Ask Him to remove any complacency toward the Word of God by the believers. Call on Him to stir the believers to be doers of the Word and not simply hearers of the Word (**James 1:22-24**).

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for those still struggling in our city from the tornadoes and other events.

- Pray for those impacted to feel the love of God's people.
- Pray for God to provide for their mental, emotional, physical, and, most importantly, their spiritual needs.
- Pray for churches as we go into the community to provide help.
- Pray for the international community as they struggle through this with limited language capacity.

### FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for Living Hope as we seek to be faithful citizens of the Kingdom of God.

- Pray that we would be a people of prayer.
- Pray that we would be a people committed to serving Jesus, our king.
- Pray that we would be a people committed to seeing God's Kingdom grow in us.
- Pray we would be a people committed to seeing God's Kingdom grow through us as we share our hope in Jesus.

### SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gatherings tomorrow.

We continue our series: **Praying for Kingdom Victory**

**Text: Matthew 6:13 | Main Thrust:** The victory of the Kingdom of God is to overcome evil. God does not tempt (**Jms.1:13**), but He allows His citizens to be tempted and face trials to bring Him glory and to strengthen His citizens' faith.

- Challenge people to overcome the sin that so easily entangles by trusting in the power of the Gospel, which will result in humble freedom for us and glory to God.
- Encourage people to know God has a plan for temptation. We are to pray, as Jesus told Peter to pray (**Mt.26:41**), but to know that we will face temptation. We can overcome through Christ.
- Teach people how to trust God as He guides us through the world of temptation so that we can be delivered from evil. Teach what it means to be delivered from evil.
- Help people see life from a realistic perspective. The Kingdom of God has come and it is still coming. It is here, but not yet fully. Until Christ returns, temptation will be a constant battle, but the King has won the victory and the Kingdom of God can be realized more in us, our homes, church, and world.
