### SATURDAY: The Plan of the Kingdom of God in the Gospels

**Title: The Demands of the Plan | Text: Mark 10:13-31**

**Main Thrust:** God demands we come to Him with child-like faith that does not depend on personal merit, strength, or ability. Those who are saved are saved by faith in Christ alone.

- Challenge people to avoid being deceived by the lie of self-sufficiency. We are all dependent on others, and especially on God. We must all come to Him as children or not at all.

- Encourage people with the freedom that humility and child-like faith provides.
- Teach people why Jesus only told this young man to sell everything. He only told him to do this out of all the people He talked to, as recorded in the Scriptures. The similar call of God on us all is the demand that we reject what once defined us and saved us and instead trust in Christ alone.
- Help people understand the deception of wealth and to gain a Biblical perspective on wealth. It is a tool. It is a blessing to give to God and serve with what we have for His purpose.
