### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would convict and save any deceived, unregenerate church members who attend church but have never repented of sin and believed in Jesus for salvation.

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for churches serving in hard places.

- Pray for their pastors and leaders to have hope and to be encouraged in God's will for their lives.
- Pray for their membership to remain faithful and steadfast.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to awaken their families, neighbors, and enemies to be awakened and saved.
- Pray for God to be glorified in their service and sacrifice.
- Pray for churches in easier places to pray for and provide resources that help them.

### FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for FLIP to be a great success.

- Pray for all the children to be either saved or revived.
- Pray for safety and health of all the participants.
- Pray for staff and volunteers to be joyful and to enjoy the week.
- Pray for God to be honored and glorified in transforming lives.

### SATURDAY:

Pray for our worship gatherings as we continue our sermon series: **The Promises of the Kingdom of God**

**Sermon Title: Blessed Are Those Who Mourn | Text: Matthew 5:4**

**Main Thrust:** Sin is a disease that infects our souls and causes brokenness. The realization that sin causes guilt and shame, not only for what we've done, but what it forms us into and how it causes harm to us and others, leads us to mourn. Those who mourn sin and repent and believe the Gospel are comforted in Christ.

- Challenge people to be honest about their sin, what it has done, what it is doing, and how it impacts their lives and the lives of others.
- Encourage people to look to the Gospel of Jesus to find comfort and healing from sin.
- Teach people how the Gospel brings comfort in salvation and sanctification.
- Help people see that God comforts us so we can be a comfort to others (**2 Corinthians 1:3-4**).
