DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would give an overwhelming sense to the people of our city and nation to turn to Christ for salvation.

MONDAY: Global Impact: Barry and Carolyn Corder (Eastern Europe)

- God continues to bring new people into our lives here, such as Abur, a chicken farmer from Bangladesh who has been attending our bible study. Pray for his salvation.
- We had the pleasure of hosting two intern students from the United States for part of this summer, Addie Hunt and Brooke Neal. Please pray that God will use them to further His kingdom. More on them in June's newsletter.
- Pray for our church family both here and in the states for loving, comforting, and serving us during the passing of Carolyn's mother.
- Pray for Isaac, a 25-year-old Iranian believer who is seeking God for his future. He is a talented musician and needs direction. Pray also that he would be protected from false teaching.
- Pray for Hooman. He is a Sufi Muslim from Iran who has been attending our meetings for the past 4 months. Pray that he will come to know Jesus as his Savior and Lord.
- Pray for the School of Tomorrow. Administrators are planning for the next school year, making spiritually strategic changes in teacher training, and daily use of Scripture in the classroom.
- Pray for us to have God's grace and wisdom in knowing Carolyn's involvement at the school.
- Pray for our 17-year-old daughter Lizzie. She was diagnosed with chronic kidney disease this summer. She is taking 2 different medications to regulate her blood pressure, protein, and uric acid and help her kidneys function. They are only functioning at 60%.
