DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray for the peace and welfare of our city and nation and that a massive number of people would find spiritual peace by trusting in Christ.

Seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare. — Jer. 29:7

MONDAY: Global Impact Ministry: Mark and Parker Phillips, Western Africa

- Pray for our team as we develop a scope and sequence training program for pastors and church leaders here in Niger. The vast majority of those entrusted with shepherding the flock have had little-to-no access to any type of theological or pastoral training. We are developing a modular-based training that would cover key doctrines and how those doctrines speak into their contextual challenges. Please pray for us as we develop this training. Pray that the Lord would use these times to build up healthy churches.
- Pray for Eglise Gomni. We will be hosting a conference for our partners in the bush. This will be a time of fellowship, sharing, training, and pastoral care as we invest in these men and women who are in some of the hardest parts of the country. WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

Father, I plead that You will grant revival in order to deal with our unbelief. Jesus will not work in an atmosphere of unbelief. I believe, Lord. Help my unbelief! I pray that You will grant revival and increase our faith in You as never before in our relationship to You. As you do this, I trust that Jesus will transform lives by the power of the Holy Spirit. O God, I plead that You would remove our unbelief. Have mercy on us! Forgive our lack of faith! Grant revival so that Your people will have a renewed faith so that we can experience the miraculous power of Jesus Christ in our midst (**Hebrews 11:6; James 1:5-8**).

- Pray for God to provide blessings to those who recognize and honor God's created order.
- Pray for governments and people to recognize the sanctity of human life from conception to last breath. Every human being on the planet is made in the image of God and is precious and important.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Continue to pray for the upcoming women's (11/29) and men's (11/30) events.

- Pray for God to connect men in men's groups and women in women's groups.
- Pray for the events to honor God and inspire connection.
- Pray for new groups to form.
- Pray for ongoing groups to renew their commitment and/or start new groups.

SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gatherings as we begin our new Christmas series - *The Prince of the Kingdom of God*. Now that Jesus has come, there is hope. There is Life in the Kingdom of God under The Prince of the Kingdom of God. In this series, we will learn who this Prince is based on the prophecy of **Isaiah 9:6-7**.

Title: The Prince Is God's Son

Text: Isaiah 9:6a | Main Thrust: Jesus is the Son of God. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He is eternally begotten of the Father, not made, and with no beginning or end.

- Challenge people to receive the Son who has been given. "...to us a son is given."
- Encourage people to celebrate the Son who was born. "For to us a child is born..."
- Teach people what it means that the, "government shall be upon his shoulder," and why the name He is called by and listed is so significant.
- Help people begin celebrating the Christmas season with awe and joy.
