DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that our city would supernaturally be aware of God's presence and power in our midst and begin to treat the name of God as holy.

MONDAY: Global Impact Ministries: Jacob and Cara, Porto, Portugal:

WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

- Pray for those who will be leading the classes to be strengthened and empowered to lead.
- Pray for God to lead couples to sign up and participate.
- Pray for God to strengthen healthy marriages and bring health to struggling marriages.
- Pray for God to use Living Hope to be a place of refuge for married couples and families.

SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gatherings as we continue our new series in Galatians: **Experiencing The Gospel**. In this series, we will learn how to experience the one, true Gospel of God. There are many things that the Gospel provides that we can experience by faith.

Title: Experiencing Correction | Text: Galatians 2:11-14

Main Thrust: We all have blind spots to idols that tempt us. We need to be corrected by one another so that we can repent of the sin that so easily entangles us and that we easily ignore and get comfortable with.

- Challenge people to identify their idols and the fear of missing out that must be done away with.
- Encourage people to seek out and be open to receive correction. This takes humility and confidence in Christ. We all have a gap between our belief and behavior that must be corrected or else we'll fall.
- Teach people how Peter gave into his idol of acceptance and prejudice, and how Paul corrected him.
- Help people acknowledge their natural blindness and to be willing to repent and hold to the Gospel way of life that is
 produced by those who believe.
