### March Memory Verse:

**Galatians 5:22-23** *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.*

### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that Living Hope would be committed to making true disciples of the next generation so that an awakening can occur.

### MONDAY: Global Impact Ministries

- Pray for the work that our three teams did last week: the Southern Europe teaching and college teams as well as the Eastern Europe teaching team. Pray for fruit from the evangelism done by our college team and wise and effective leadership resulting from our two teaching teams.
- Pray for our staff as we consider new and wise ways to send our members and support our international partners.

### TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for the people who come into the Centers for Biblical Counseling and Pregnancy. ### WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

**Luke 10:2** *"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."*

Pray for Living Hope to be mindful and bold to share our hope in Christ with those around us this week. Ask God to enable us to effectively invite thousands of people to our Easter services.

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for a new initiative by the Commonwealth Policy Center, a nonpartisan group that helps educate people in Kentucky concerning public policy issues.

- Pray for the event at Living Hope on Saturday, April 15, from 8:30-11:30. It will offer teachers, administrators, and parents the opportunity to hear about how federal and state guidelines are to be understood, and how Christians can respond rightly to them based on their identity in Christ.
- Pray for Christian professors, teachers, and administrators whose rights are being threatened by policies coming from school and governmental authorities.
- Pray for students who are being taught immoral ideas and practices, and also destructive worldview ideologies as if they are good and right.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to bring a great awakening through Christians in education systems.

### FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Continue to pray for Living Hope as we continue **Phase 2** of the **10:2 Focus** – sharing.

- Pray for each person to be faithful to continue to pray for those who need Christ and to share their hope with those they have been praying for.
- Pray for God to awaken hundreds of people to repent and believe the Gospel shared by Hopers.
- Pray for God to be glorified as we share the hope we have in Christ.
- Pray for God to use Living Hope to be a healthy, disciple-making church.

### SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gatherings and our series in Galatians: **Experiencing Good News.**

**Title: Experiencing Church | Text: Galatians 6:1-10**

**Main Thrust:** Every saint is called to live in and in service to a local church.
