Monthly Memorization

DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would convict and save any deceived, unregenerate church members who attend church, but have never repented of sin and believed in Jesus for salvation.

MONDAY: Global Impact: The Phillips Family

- Pray for Michael and Sarah as they study French to quickly grasp the language and be able to communicate to the people of Niger.
- Pray for the Christians in the Alambar region. Pray they will continue to meet despite being threatened by the jihadists that doing so will bring about disaster.
- Pray for Moises as he leads our work among the Fulani. They are one of the most resistant groups and live in very dangerous areas. While there are many scattered believers, there are few churches.

TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for the Centers for Hope. Pray that in the Counseling and Pregnancy Centers, the community will find a place of refuge, a place where they encounter the Lord and experience His love, protection, and salvation. *“But let all who take refuge in you rejoice; let them ever sing for joy, and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may exalt you. WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

Luke 10:2 *“The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.”*

Pray this prayer for Living Hope: *Father, I plead that You will grant revival in order to deal with our unbelief. Jesus will not work in an atmosphere of unbelief. I believe, Lord; help my unbelief! I pray that You will grant revival and increase our faith in You as never before in our relationship with You. As you do this, I trust that Jesus will transform lives by the power of the Holy Spirit. O God, I plead that You would remove our unbelief. Have mercy on us! Forgive our lack of faith! Grant revival so that Your people will have a renewed faith so that we can experience the miraculous power of Jesus Christ in our midst (Hebrews 11:6; James 1:5-8).*

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for nations of the world in turmoil.

- Pray for Niamey, Africa to have peace in their government system and for the Church to thrive.
- Pray for Israel to have peace and the conflict to end with a permanent solution.
- Pray for India to allow Christians to gather without threat of attack.
- Pray for Europe to be blessed with peace among the nations and for the Church to be revived.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Ask God to provide for our next generation, college, and young adult ministries.

- Ask God to bless us with a parenting pastor to disciple our families.
- Ask God to bless our next generation ministries to see large numbers of students saved and revived.
- Ask God to bless our college and young adult ministries to lead many to saving faith.
- Ask God to guide our pastors, ministers, and leadership teams to know and do God’s will.

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our new series: Refresh Your Priorities

This Sunday: Serve Generously | Text: John 13:2-5; 12-16

Main Thrust: To be a disciple of Jesus is to choose to live like Jesus more and more every day. Jesus came to serve generously. To be a disciple of Jesus is to be a servant who serves generously.

- Challenge people to know what God has done for them, who God has made them to be, and where God is guiding them to go so that they have the confidence to serve generously.
- Encourage people to delight in out-serving others and being seen as a great servant of God.
