Monthly Memorization

DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God's people throughout the world would be bold to share the hope they have in Jesus Christ for salvation and provision, despite any opposition of unbelievers.

And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all boldness, — Acts 4:29

MONDAY: Urban Unreached Impact

Hispanic Ministry:

- Pray for the growth of our ministry leaders and that they are well equipped.
- Pray for the discipleship group these ministry leaders will be a part of. Pray they will learn to serve more intentionally while also being cared for.
- Pray for the process of possibly the Hispanic ministry convening as a church.
- Pray for the Hispanic ministry's outreach efforts. Pray that many will hear the message of Jesus and will surrender their lives to Him.
- Pray for the spiritual growth of the ministry leaders. They have been encountering spiritual warfare in certain seasons and trials. Pray that in these times, they will wholly rely on Christ, who is Lord over all.

Afghan Ministry:

- Pray for Yazdan. He continues to suffer for his people. There's many days and nights that he sacrifices to meet a family in need so that they can see the Christ who sacrificed Himself for them through Yazdan's sacrifices.
- Pray that the Lord continues to sustain Yazdan in this ministry.
- Pray for Yazdan's wife, Majara, as she nears the end of her pregnancy.
- There are a few people who have expressed deep interest in Jesus that Yazdan has been able to meet with. One of these people read through four books of the Bible one night, extending into the morning. But there's hesitancy for them to fully surrender their lives to Christ. It will bring down scorn from the community. If they have any family still in Afghanistan, they may be in danger. Pray that they can see the invaluable worth of Christ and that He is worth it all.

TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for those who are lost. Pray they come into the Centers for Hope. Pray that, as advocates and counselors share the truth of the Gospel with them, God will open the eyes, ears, and hearts of those who hear. Pray they will, "confess with their mouths that Jesus is Lord and believe in their heart that God raised him from the dead," and they will be saved. **Romans 10:9**

WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

Luke 10:2 *"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."*

- Pray for God's people to live in peace with one another.
- Pray for God's people to share their hope of peace with lost people and lead them to trust in Christ and gain peace with God, peace within, and peace with others.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Ask God to bless us as we seek to Refresh our Relationships.

- Pray for couples to make peace and refresh their marriage.
- Pray for families to make peace and sustain peace by glorifying God and obeying His commands.
- Pray for friends that are in conflict to make peace with one another.
- Pray for Living Hope to be united in peace, love, and faith, and sustain the bond of peace in Christ.

SATURDAY: Pray as we begin our new series: Refresh Your Relationships

In this series, we will learn The Four Laws of Biblical Peacemaking and how to *Refresh Our Relationships*.

This Sunday: Get the Log Out of Your Own Eye | Text: Matthew 7:3-5

Main Thrust: Conflict rarely comes about because of the actions of one person. For there to be peace, each person in conflict must own up to their part of the conflict and seek forgiveness.

- Challenge people to be self-aware and willing to take responsibility for their sin.
- Encourage people to be humble and to happily repent for their wrongs that created conflict.
- Teach people how to rightly apologize using the *Seven A's of Confession*.
- Help people who may only be 1% responsible for the conflict to take 100% responsibility for their 1%.
