DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

MONDAY: Global Impact – The Burnham Family

- Praise for our family. The boys have 2 weeks off school for Easter, so we plan to have fun traveling around the UK and enjoying family time!

This Sunday: Resurrection Life | Text: Romans 6:5-11

- Challenge people to die to sin so they can live in Christ.
