This Sunday: What is our problem? | Text: Genesis 3

Main Thrust: The world says that our problems are social, economic, and political. Those are just fruits of a root. The root problem with humanity is sin. No amount of money, education, or success can overcome the brokenness sin causes. The Gospel is our only hope.

- Challenge people to overcome the deception of the Devil with the truth.
- Encourage people to flee to God and not away from Him to seek His grace.
- Teach people how the blood of Jesus and His covering of righteousness resolves our problem.
- Help people understand why God removed us from Eden, what it means to pursue God by faith outside of Eden, and how our problem will finally and fully be resolved when Christ returns.
