DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Father, You have declared in Your Word that if I call to You that You will show me great and mighty things which I do not know. I am calling to You, O God! SATURDAY: Pray for God to bless our new series: **Refreshing Your Beliefs**

This Sunday: Does the culture of a nation matter? | Text: Romans 1:28-32

Main Thrust: The world says that there is no grand narrative that defines reality and that all that matters is individual choice. The Bible teaches that there is a grand story being lived out whose author is God, and those who live outside of that story create lifestyles and a culture that is destructive and will destroy itself.

- Challenge people to know where our culture is and is going, what it believes (creed), how we can offer counterpoints to its beliefs, and ultimately point people to Christ.
- Encourage people to become exegetes of culture and scripture so they can work to align their lives around Christ and point others to Him as well.
- Teach people how the Bible describes a destructive culture and what Christians can do to preserve what is good and right and best in a culture.
- Help people not to lose hope, but to focus on the sovereignty of God to provide for His Kingdom purpose for His Kingdom citizens.
