Title: Your Phone Is a Trap | Text: James 1:14-15

Main Thrust: A smart phone is a tool. It will either be a tool that you use to do your work that is meant to form you into Christ's image, or it will be a tool that someone else uses to form you into what they want.

- Challenge people to recognize the power of a smartphone to steal your time, kill your focus, and destroy your conscience.
- Encourage people to discipline how they use their smartphone.
- Teach people how a smartphone can go from being a tool we use to a tool that is used to lure and entice us with desires that lead us to sin that will destroy our relationships and lives.
- Help people decide how to use technology so that it leads to human flourishing rather than unhealthy mental, emotional, and physical lifestyles.
