DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would provide opportunities for the Gospel to penetrate unreached people groups and Gospel-aware, but disinterested people in our city.

MONDAY: Global Impact - The Burnham Family

Message: *There Was a Dream and a Fulfillment* | **Text:** **Genesis 50:15-21**

Main Thrust: There are no accidents. There is only providence. It was no accident that, like Joseph, Jesus was rejected by His brothers, abandoned by His friends, and suffered injustice. It was for God's purpose.

- Challenge people to trust God's purpose for their own suffering and learn obedience from it as Jesus did.
- Encourage people to know that Jesus went through all He did, just as Joseph did, to accomplish God's purpose – the salvation of many.
