DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that the people of Living Hope will be known for holy lives and that the church's good works would shine as a light in our city.

You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. — Matt. 5:14

MONDAY: The Urban and Unreached Ministry

- Pray for new local partners who can help engage new communities and people groups who are the least reached in Bowling Green.
- Pray for a local non-Christian, religious leader of one of the least-reachable groups. He is reading the scriptures. Pray that the Spirit will reveal the truth about Jesus to him.

The Urban and Unreached Ministry also wants to praise how the Lord is moving around them:

- Praise God for the believers he has sent out to share the good news with the least reached in our city. His word is bearing fruit and souls are being saved.
- Praise God for his faithfulness in supplying all our needs to host a Christmas party for a least-reached group. Over 100 people attended and heard the story of Christ's birth.

TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for those who come into The Centers for Hope who are grieving, hurting from life circumstances, and entangled in sin. Pray they will be free from the troubles of their hearts, the anguish that afflicts them, and the loneliness that encompasses them. *"Turn to me and be gracious to me, for I am lonely and afflicted. The troubles of my heart have multiplied; free me from my anguish."* **Psalms 25:16-17**

WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

Luke 10:2 *"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."*

Pray that we will be faithful to invite others to know Jesus and gather with us for worship to learn who He is, what He is doing, and what He has promised to do.

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for our nation as we begin a new year with so many dangers in the world.

- Pray for God to provide laws that produce freedom, justice, protection, health, safety, and prosperity through our newly-elected leaders.
- Pray that the executive, judicial, and legislative branches of government will create renewed confidence among the people in our leaders and government.
- Pray for the Church to be faithful to Christ and function as salt and light as He has commanded us to.
- Pray for Christians to be faithful to pray for God's protection and provision.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Ask God to bless Living Hope as we begin Equip.

- Ask God to bless our church family to engage in Equip.
- Ask God to bless our marriage trainings (Merge, re|engage, & Grace Marriage).
- Ask God to bless our Equip classes.
- Ask God to bless our Parent Ministry training.

SATURDAY: Pray as we begin our new year-long focus: ***Stories of Promised Hope***. The Old Testament pointed to the coming of Jesus Christ and His new covenant. Beginning with Moses and working through the prophets, we will seek the promised hope of Jesus in the OT.

The first series is ***Once Upon A Time***. In this series, we will look at some stories in the Bible written by Moses. These stories show the heart of God and reveal the plan of God to save the people of God by grace through the redemptive work of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

Message: There Was a Fall & a Rescue | Text: Genesis 3

Main Thrust: Humanity committed treason and fell into sin and judgment. God did not abandon us. God provided a blood sacrifice and a covering along with His blessing of transformation. This provision points to Jesus and His power to save.
