SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our new year-long focus: *Stories of Promised Hope* in our first series: **Once Upon a Time. Message: There Was a Lamb & a Journey | Text: Exodus 12:1 – 20:21 (1 Corinthians 10:1-6)**

Main Thrust: God saved Israel from the bondage of slavery by the blood of the lamb, led them through water, gave them the law to sanctify them, and led them to the promised land. God's people are saved by the blood of The Lamb, are baptized through water, are given the Spirit and Word to be sanctified, and are being led to heaven – the promise land.

- Challenge people to trust in the sacrifice of Jesus to save from the coming judgment of God.
- Encourage people to be baptized, discipled, and to follow the way of Jesus by the power of the Spirit.
- Teach people how to be victorious in this wilderness that is our broken world by receiving living water from Christ, who is the Solid Rock.
- Help people to hate evil and not desire it as Israel did.
