Message: There Was a Death & a Savior | Text: Deuteronomy 31:1-8

Main Thrust: God leads us in Jesus. We no longer rely on people, rules, or ceremonies – the way of religion. Moses' death provided the ability for the people to enter God's promise by God leading them through Joshua. The death and resurrection of Jesus provides us the ability to enter God's promise and be led by the Spirit.

- Challenge people to see that Jesus died for our sin. Had we not sinned Jesus would not have had to die the way He did. If Moses had not sinned, he would not have had to die the way he did. The consequence of sin is death.
- Encourage people to trust in Jesus and be led by Him.
- Teach people what it looks like to be strong and courageous under the leadership of Jesus.
- Help people see that the promise land can only be entered by faith as we follow Jesus, who has gone and now goes before us.
