DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

MONDAY: Global Impact – The Corder Family

- Pray for the health of their family members.
- Pray their family can be healthy as they plan to go back to Georgia.
- Pray for their Iranian Fellowship in Georgia. They have been facing many challenges. Almost all Iranians in Georgia have now had their residency canceled and received deportation notices.
- Pray for God to provide for their financial needs. They still need to raise \$2,500 additional monthly support before their organization allows them to return to the mission field by June 1.

Message: Trust the Plan of God | Text: Ruth 4:13-21

Main Thrust: God's eternal plan was for this Moabite woman to be in the line of Jesus. His plan is perfect. He is never late. His plan is going to get done.

- Challenge God's people to join in on God's plan to provide for the life He has planned for us (v.15)
- Encourage people to know God is sovereign and His plan is going to happen.
- Teach God's people to encourage and celebrate God's plan being realized in each other's lives.
- Help people see Jesus proclaimed through this provision of His family (v.22). He is the son of David according to the eternal plan of God.
