Message: Heroes Arise! | Text: 1 Samuel 1:2-11

Main Thrust: Jesus has come. He is coming again! He is our hero. Samuel and David picture Jesus as heroes who arose to save and lead God's people, as Jesus now does to rescue and soon restore all things.

- Challenge people to believe that Jesus has come to rescue us and will come again to restore all things.
- Encourage people to believe that God has a plan to bring about His Kingdom purpose in the world.
- Teach people how Samuel and David picture Jesus' coming and treatment (Isaiah 53:2-3), current Kingdom (Isaiah 53:4-6), and His coming Kingdom (Isaiah 54:5-10).
- Help people trust in God's plan for their life in His Kingdom purpose.
