SATURDAY: Pray as we begin our new series: Songs of the Redeemed

This summer, we are going to study a number of Psalms to learn what they tell us about Jesus, and celebrate what they tell us about being His redeemed people.

Title: Kiss the King | Text: Psalm 2

Main Thrust: This Messianic Psalm tells of the sonship, might, dominion, and holy justice of Christ and the importance of having peace with Him, as the Redeemed.

- Challenge people to fear the Lord and to live in awe of Him.
- Encourage people to see the willingness of God to be gracious because Jesus has satisfied with His sacrificial death the just wrath of God that we deserve.
- Teach people how Jesus is pictured in this Psalm as the coming King of kings who will rule forever and ever as the Son of God.
- Help people understand that greatness of God, the mercy of Christ, and our need for grace because we are born in the kingdom of darkness that is against the LORD and His Anointed.
