SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our new series: Songs of the Redeemed

Title: Give Him Praise | Text: Psalm 8

Main Thrust: This Psalm of praise reveals the privileged position mankind has as the image bearers of God. Jesus became one of us. Jesus referred to Himself as, "the son of man." He became like us so that we could become like Him.

- Challenge people to acknowledge their unique ontology as a creature made in the image of God with the responsibility to be a moral agent who is accountable to God unlike any other creature.
- Encourage people with the honor it is to have had Christ to become one of us so that we could become like Him. He didn't take on any other form. Jesus became a son of man to save mankind.
- Teach people how Jesus is proclaimed as the ultimate and only perfect human being to live as God designed so that we can receive and enjoy His righteous life imputed to us.
- Help people see the value of human life and the importance of spreading the Gospel so that others can know their worth and the love God has for them in Christ.
