Main Thrust: This Psalm is a lament that points to the suffering of Christ and of all mankind because of sin. It proclaims the work of Christ and celebrates His victory that gives life and blessings to the Redeemed.

- Challenge people to lament the hard things in life without shame or despair.
- Encourage people to know that Christ identifies with us having struggled in life with the same temptations but has overcome.
- Teach people how this Psalm pictures and proclaims Christ as the promised hope who committed His spirit into the hands of God in death and has been raised to be our rock and refuge.
- Help people understand why we can rejoice and be glad in the steadfast love of God given to us in Christ who was afflicted and is now raised and living in a broad place, heaven.
