DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our new series: Songs of the Redeemed

Title: Know His Joy | Text: Psalm 16

Main Thrust: This Messianic Psalm tells of the blessedness of being the Redeemed of God and how it is the Redeemed of God think, feel, and live (The Gospel you believe determines the life that you live and the emotions that you feel.) It tells of the unique relationship Jesus has with the Father and the similar relationship we have with the Father because of our redeemed relationship with Jesus.

- Challenge people to know the fullness of joy that comes with being saved and not abandoned in death (to Sheol) to remain eternally in corruption.
- Encourage people to trust in how the redeemed are cared for under the sovereign power of God.
- Teach people how Jesus is pictured as the Promised One who won’t see decay (**Acts 13:35**) and will enjoy the constant presence of the Father (**Acts 2:35**).
- Help people to delight in the provision and purpose of God enjoyed by the Redeemed.
