### **DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:**

Pray that Living Hope would contend for the faith without being contentious so that our hope may be proclaimed with clarity to our homes, our neighbors, and every generation in our city. *I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints. ~ Jude 3*

### **MONDAY: Global Impact - Burnham Family, Western Europe**

Pray for those the Living Hope Evangelism team impacted last week! We were so excited to host our first LH team here in London. We went out each day offering prayer, looking for people of peace, sharing the gospel, and looking for opportunities to follow up with discipleship. Pray for the lost who were engaged.

#### Praise:

- We praise the Lord for the over 200 Europeans, South Americans, African, Middle Eastern, Central Asian, and South Asian church planters in Europe trained this past month. We are so excited to serve these faithful brothers and sisters through training, coaching, and encouragement.
- We have seen the Lord move in great ways across Europe. Most recently we saw former Muslim refugees who now love Jesus, training European pastors how to share the gospel, make disciples, and plant new churches! This is part of the vision God gave us years ago while serving in Greece. We are so pumped to see God using these new followers of Jesus to bring His Kingdom back to Europe!

### **TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center**

Thank the Lord that, through Christ, we have been set free as believers. Pray for the individuals who come through the doors of The Pregnancy and Counseling Centers to experience that freedom in Christ. ### **WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus**

*The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Luke 10:2*

Ask God to bless those returning from mission trips to share their enthusiasm for reaching the lost and continue to live on mission in Bowling Green with the same fervor they did while serving in our cities.

### **THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world**

Ask God to bless church planters in Western Europe.

- Pray for the pastors and their families to thrive in their cities and be strengthened in their faith.
- Pray for the people in the cities who are hearing the Gospel. Pray they repent, believe, and begin to pursue and recover God's Design through baptism and living as ambassadors in their communities as they experience the Disciple's Life.
- Pray for God to provide men and women who love Jesus to join them in their efforts.
- Pray for God to raise up leaders from within these new congregations to be called into faithful service.

### **FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.**

Ask God to bless new groups being launched this August.

- Pray for God to empower each group member to be faithful to engage.
- Pray for each meeting to be Spirit-led and Spirit-formed.
- Pray for the participants to live out what they are learning and begin to function as faithful ambassadors of Jesus by praying and sharing with those on their impact maps.
- Pray for God to transform lives with His Word.

### **SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our series: Songs of the Redeemed**

Title: Join His Rescue | Text: Psalm 68:18-19

**Main Thrust:** This is a Psalm of praise and imprecation that points to the victorious work of Christ for His people. In vv.18-19, Christ is pictured as the Redeemer who leads His people out of defeat and death and into victorious life. It is quoted in Ephesians 4:8.

- Challenge people see Christ as the ultimate Redeemer of the saints and judge of sinners.
- Encourage people that redemption is given to the rebellious by grace through faith.
- Teach people that salvation is more than renewed standing. It provides a new way of life under the leadership of Jesus.
- Help people see how this points to Jesus and how He will one day return and bring about the ultimate victory and praise in the new heavens and earth.
