DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God will create a spirit of humility and brokenness among the believers (**Isaiah 57:15; James 4:6**). God will not revive those who are self-sufficient and proud. The believers must come to see their spiritual bankruptcy and utter dependence on God.

MONDAY: Global Impact - Corder Family, headed to the country of Georgia

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our series: Songs of the Redeemed

Title: Accept His Lordship | Text: Psalm 72

Main Thrust: This is a Messianic Psalm that blesses the King and His reign. The Redeemed rejoice in the Lordship of Christ, while the lost recoil at His authority.

- Challenge people to happily live under the worthy Lordship of Jesus.
- Encourage people to see the blessedness of a life lived by God's design.
- Teach people how this Psalm was originally used but ultimately pictures Christ and His reign.
- Help people understand the greatness of God and desire to live under His Lordship.
