Title: He Saves & Sends! | Text: Daniel 3

Main Thrust: Jesus is present with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. His appearance and saving power pictures Jesus as the one who enters our fallen broken world and all the of the consequences, and He overcomes to save and then send!

- Challenge people to trust God and see their circumstances through the lens of God who does big things rather than seeing God through the lens of their broken circumstances.
- Encourage people that God is with us always. We can go through anything with hope because He is with us to save us in life and death.
- Teach people how this experience shows how Jesus brings salvation and then sends His people into the fallen world to exercise influence and make His Gospel known.
- Help people be bold witnesses living on mission for Jesus so that others, like Neb, can attain the knowledge of the big things God does – “for there is no other god who is able to rescue in this way.”
