DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray for needs of the United States.

- Pray for the 233,000 missing children who crossed into the U.S. illegally to be located. There were 31,000 unaccompanied children released to sponsor addresses that were blank, undeliverable, or incomplete, and 43,000 children with their “sponsors” failed to appear for court hearings and are now effectively missing from federal monitoring according to Inspector General’s July 2025 report.
- Pray for the U.S. economy to produce jobs and prices for goods that enable families to thrive.
- Pray for the healthcare industry to be able to adapt and provide good healthcare for patients at manageable costs that produce profits and jobs.
- Pray for the education system to do what is best for students so that the next generation has the tools to enter the workforce and provide for their families and communities.
