- Our Kurdish Iranian friend, Diako, is to receive a Canadian work visa. His Georgian residency runs out in a month. His Ukrainian wife left two weeks ago for Edmonton to live with Diako's brother and sister.
- Pray for our Iranian friends, Ebi, his wife, Mozhi, and their daughter, Amitris. They were granted another year of Georgian residency a few weeks ago but have now been informed that they need to appear in court in mid-December to determine whether they will be able to stay or not. It isn't very clear.
- Pray for our Iranian friend, Zhila. She injured her leg last week and is trying to get back to Iran for medical help because she has medical insurance in Iran.
- Pray for opportunities to meet new Iranians, especially our neighbors below us. We are having supper at their house tomorrow evening.

Praise:

- God has been moving by putting new Iranians in our path. Our neighbors include Barry's Farsi language teacher, Barry's barber, and a taxi driver with whom Barry is going to meet for Farsi language practice.
- Praise God, we were able to purchase a vehicle. Barry's 84-year-old mother was recently placed in the Owensboro hospital for an infection in her hand. She has recovered well and is back home. Our relationship with Pastor Merab and the church he pastors continues to grow stronger. Our family is doing well and staying healthy.
