Title: As a Priest | Text: Genesis 14:17-24

- Challenge people to embrace Jesus as the High Priest of their soul.
- Encourage people with the hope of the “better covenant” (7:22) with “better promises” (8:6) and a “better hope!” (7:19).
- Teach people who Melchizedek is, what his name means, and how He pictures Jesus.
- Help people embrace Jesus as the ultimate priest who mediates the only eternal saving covenant.
