Title: Trust | Text: Luke 11:5-13 / Matthew 7:7-11

Main Thrust: God has given us His Son. If He did not withhold His greatest and most precious gift, we have every reason to trust that He will not withhold what is truly good for us. Therefore, we can trust God with every need and request.

- **Challenge people** to trust that it is no burden for God to hear our prayers or to provide for our needs. Everything is small to God.
- **Encourage people** that Jesus is the faithful friend of the redeemed and that the Father is the perfect Father to His children, who delights to give good gifts. If it matters to us, it matters to Him.
- **Teach people** how to ask, seek, and knock with persevering faith, trusting that God will give, that we will find, and that doors will be opened according to His wisdom.
- **Help people** trust in God's power and provision, knowing that He is able and faithful to do what only He can do.
