DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would provide opportunities for the Gospel to penetrate both unreached people groups and those in our city who are Gospel-aware but spiritually disinterested.

At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ. — Col. 4:3

MONDAY: Evan and Annie Day (CRU, Marshall University)

- We are leading summer missions to the Middle East this summer. So, planning for 33 people in the Middle East for six weeks is a big task! Pray for energy, wisdom in planning, and that the Lord will move through our team this summer!
- Pray that in the midst of all the planning, we'd still have a fruitful time on campus this spring!
- Pray for the 20+ students who've trusted Christ this year as we continue to try pouring into them. Pray that their faith would be firmly established before they return home for the summer - many are the first in the family to know Christ.
- Pray for good rest! It's easy to always try doing more, but pray that as a step of faith, we would rest well in this full season, trusting the Lord as we rest.

Ask God to bless DNow, a discipleship weekend for middle & high school students from area churches.

- Pray for God to save lost students who attend.
- Pray for God to bless the student ministries to grow closer to God and one another.
- Pray for God to bless the youth pastors of the area to grow closer for greater Kingdom partnership.
- Pray for God to keep all of the students and leaders safe and healthy over the weekend.

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our 3rd series of the year: The Heart of Living Hope Transforms!

Title: Priorities | Text: Luke 16:1-13

Main Thrust: As disciples of Jesus, Christ must be our highest priority. Every responsibility, desire, and possession must be submitted to and shaped by our allegiance to Him.

- **Challenge people** to leverage their resources to build Christ-centered community and advance His kingdom.
- **Encourage people** to be wise and faithful stewards—shrewd in handling worldly wealth so it is used to its fullest redemptive potential.
- **Teach people** how prioritizing Jesus in earthly matters prepares and enables us to be entrusted with true spiritual riches.
- **Help people** see that the true riches of life are found in the things of God, and that we must intentionally prioritize what matters most.
