DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that our city would supernaturally be aware of God's presence and power in our midst and begin to treat the name of God as holy.

MONDAY: Global Impact - Barry and Carolyn Corder, serving among Iranian refugees in the transcontinental region of Eastern Europe/Western Asia

- Pray for individual and cooperate spiritual growth of the Iranians in our home Bible Study and that God would add to our number and grow our group.
- Pray for the safety and the liberation of the Iranian people from Islamic tyranny.
- Pray for 6 Iranians from our home fellowship who are now living inside Iran. Pray they will stand firm and continue to grow in their faith in Christ in the midst of the crisis in which they are living.
- Pray for the doors to be opened so that we can get into Iran for ministry and take about 500 Farsi Bibles into Iran.
- Pray for 13 unbelieving Iranians that we have relationships with to be open to spiritual conversations and become transformed by the power of the gospel.
- Pray for Barry's teaching and discipleship times with believers in Batumi and opportunities to share the gospel with Muslims in that area.

TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for the people who come into the Centers for Biblical Counseling and Pregnancy. Pray their eyes will be opened to understanding that, "*the thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy*," but Christ, "*came that they may have life and have it abundantly*." **John 10:10**

SATURDAY: Pray as we finish our 3rd series of the year: The Heart of Living Hope Transforms!

Title: All Things | Text: Matthew 13:33

Main Thrust: In this brief parable, Jesus takes a metaphor that is often used negatively – yeast – and employs it positively to illustrate the pervasive, transforming influence of the Kingdom of Heaven. Though it may begin small and hidden, the Kingdom works powerfully and persistently until it permeates everything.

- **Challenge people** to understand the miracle and majesty of the Kingdom of Heaven and to stand in awe that we are invited to participate in it.
- **Encourage people** to live as “yeast” in the world and to faithfully and intentionally spread the Gospel that transforms all things.
- **Teach people** how we who have been transformed by the Gospel have become ambassadors of the Kingdom and as such are agents of lasting and eternal change.

- **Help people** to see the honor and privilege of being members and ambassadors of the Kingdom of Heaven and the oversized impact we can have as simple, small, saved servants of Jesus.
