DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would convict and save any deceived, unregenerate church members, who attend church, but have never repented of sin and believed in Jesus for salvation.

“Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.” — Matthew 7:21

MONDAY: Digital Impact - Wes and Leah Brooks, a ministry they created called Lightworks. Their ministry is dedicated to reaching the lost and discipling believers in the digital spaces.

- After a difficult season of continuous sickness for Ezra for the past 14 months and significant illness for Wes (hospitalization, flu, bronchitis, pneumonia), we prayed and fasted for healing and answers with our community in January. One outcome was that several people mentioned "mold." We had our house inspected and toxic mold was found in our HVAC system and kitchen, so we moved out of our house last week to have it remediated. We would so appreciate prayers for (1) swift and quality work by the remediators and rebuilders, and (2) health for Wes and Ezra in the meantime – both are sick, but we're hoping moving out of our home helps them to recover faster.
- Please also pray for a few ministry projects. Pray that the momentum continues and that we would see God at work in the lives of people piloting our discipleship platform. Join us in praising God for the mold "revelation" and provision of a stable place to stay while our house is worked on.

TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray for the counselors and advocates as they boldly speak the truth in love to the people that we counsel, even when it is difficult, and we know that they may not respond well. *“Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ.”*

WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Luke 10:2

Continue to pray that God would richly bless our **Day of Hope on March 28** as we serve Bowling Green with Christlike love and faithfully share the Gospel.

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Continue to pray for peace in the Middle East and for U.S. military personnel serving there.

- Pray that the United States would carry out its mission with wisdom, integrity, and effectiveness, promoting peace, safety, and freedom.
- Pray for the families of deployed service members, asking God to grant them comfort, strength, hope, and peace.
- Pray for lasting peace and long-term stability throughout the region.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Ask God to bless our Easter Services!

- Pray for God to move LH to invite friends and family.
- Pray for those LH invites to attend.
- Pray for God to do a great work in all who gather for worship.
- Pray for each service to be blessed by God to honor and please Him.

SATURDAY: Pray as we begin a 2-part Easter Series: The Heart of Living Hope Worship!

The Gospel transforms the heart and mind of saints so that we are compelled to worship. All human beings worship something. That's what God made us to do. But when the Gospel changes a person's life, they are compelled to give God thanks, praise Him, and ask God to be at work in their lives and their world.

Title: The King Who Is Coming! | Text: Matthew 21:11

Main Thrust: Jesus came into Jerusalem as promised by Zechariah 9:9. The crowds had a sense of who this man was who had come and is The King Who Is Coming!

- **Challenge people** to see that Jesus fulfilled the prophesy to come into Jerusalem to bring salvation to mankind through His death and resurrection and will keep the prophecy to return and bring judgment salvation to the whole world through His life and reign (**Isaiah 65**).
- **Encourage people** to repent and believe the Gospel and submit to the reign of King Jesus.

- **Teach people** how the Gospel works to save and how, when Christ comes again, He will bring the final judgment, and all will remain in their state of sin or holiness.
- **Help people** understand the seriousness of the coming of Jesus.
