DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God will grant the true believers of Christ an agonizing burden for lost people and an unceasing desire to share the gospel with them.

MONDAY: Global Impact - Jacob and Cara Stevens, Northern Portugal

Title: Title: The King Who Has Conquered! | Text: Mattew 28:1-8

Main Thrust: Jesus, who was crucified, has been raised from the dead by the power of God, fulfilling His promises and demonstrating His victory over death. The empty tomb and the angel's announcement call the disciples to respond with faith, reverent awe, and joyful urgency to *The King Who Has Conquered!*

- **Challenge people** to repent and believe the Gospel.
- **Encourage people** to know that Jesus has won the battle over sin and death and is the Promised One (Genesis 3:15) who is victorious (1 Cor 15:50-58).
- **Teach people** how the victory of Jesus changes everything!
- **Help people** see and receive the blessings that come to those who believe in *The King Who Has Conquered!*
