#### **DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:**

Pray that Living Hope would contend for the faith without being contentious so that our hope may be proclaimed with clarity to our homes, our neighbors, and every generation in our city.

#### **MONDAY: Global Impact - Will and Laura Burnham, training and sending missionaries throughout Europe to pursue unreached people groups**

- Praise for the Afghan work in Germany! Yohanna (John) and his team of leaders in Germany have trained over 100 Afghan believers, 2 new churches have been planted, and over 1,500 Germans, Afghans, and Iranians have heard the gospel on the streets of Berlin, Hamburg, and Frankfurt! All this since January! We are praising God for this Kingdom activity by Yohanna and his leaders.
- Pray for Asim, his family, and Danny, as well. They each have cases involving their residency in Portugal currently. The Portuguese government is making immigration extremely difficult in 2026. We even have IMB missionaries potentially losing their residency status this year. Please be in prayer, mainly for persons of peace at the immigration office when they apply.
- Pray for Will. He is traveling to 3 different countries to provide training in March and early April. Also, pray for Laura and the boys as Will travels.
- Pray for a Living Hope team arriving in March! We are hosting 6 students from the college ministry for a week of evangelism in the streets of London. We are partnering with a local church in our area to model for them how to do evangelism alongside this team. Pray for the team to encounter persons of peace as they go out to share!

#### **TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center**

Pray for the counselors, volunteers, and staff in The Centers for Hope. Pray they would pursue a life of spiritual maturity and deepening knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. #### **WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus**

- Pray that the United States would carry out its mission with wisdom, integrity, and effectiveness, promoting peace, safety, and freedom.
- Pray for the families of deployed service members, asking God to grant them comfort, strength, hope, and peace.
- Pray for lasting peace and long-term stability throughout the region.

#### **FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.**

Ask God to bless our Impact Ministries

- Pray for our international partners and those being sent from LH to serve alongside them.
- Pray for our national partners and those who will be serving with them across the country.
- Pray for our local partnerships. Pray we would faithfully show and share Christ in our community.
- Pray for our unreached and urban ministries. Pray that people groups without an active gospel witness would encounter Christ and we would plant healthy churches among them.

#### **SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our 3rd series of the year: The Heart of Living Hope Transforms!**

**Title: Attitudes | Text: Matthew 9:16-17**

**Main Thrust:** In this parable, spoken in the form of a proverbial saying, Jesus uses familiar imagery—new cloth and new wine—to reveal the transforming reality of the New Covenant. His coming does not patch up the old system but inaugurates something entirely new. Those who are born again in Christ must therefore adopt attitudes shaped by the new life He gives.

- **Challenge people** to embrace the fullness of the New Covenant rather than clinging to old covenant patterns and practices.

- **Encourage people** to have an attitude of gratitude and courage that flows from experiencing new life in Christ.
- **Teach people** how the new covering and new wine picture the new life and its unique features provided in Christ Jesus.
- **Help people** to cultivate the attitude of Christ as described in Philippians 2 (NIV '84), reflecting humility, obedience, and joyful submission.
