DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Ask God to bless Living Hope as we prepare for an important change in our Sunday morning schedule.

- Pray for our leaders as they communicate the changes with clarity.
- Pray for our church family to receive these changes with hope and a shared sense of purpose.
- Pray for God to guide us and bless our church as we walk faithfully through this season of transition.
- Pray that God would raise up the leaders needed to meet the opportunities and needs these changes will create.

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our 4th sermon series of the year: *The Heart of Living Hope Serves!*

Title: Those Who Live Under the Surface | **Text:** Luke 15:8-10

Main Thrust: There are people living near us, often unseen and unnoticed, who are spiritually lost and need someone to seek them out and help them discover the salvation found in Christ.

- **Challenge people** to go looking for the lost in our midst.
- **Encourage people** to rejoice in the hope of victory, remembering that the angels of God celebrate when even one sinner repents and receives new life in Christ.

- **Teach people** how they can participate in the mission of LH.
- **Help people** know that their natural abilities, personal experiences, and spiritual gifts are needed and crucial to God's Kingdom work in and through LH.
