DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

- Pray for the president, Congress, judges, and all appointed officials. Pray that they would fear God, act justly, and lead with wisdom, humility, and a commitment to the common good.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Continue to ask God to bless Living Hope as we prepare to move to four services in August.

- Pray for God to raise up volunteers and leaders to serve.
- Pray for more members to engage in EQUIP classes.
- Pray for God to draw hundreds more to gather for worship, repent, and believe the Gospel, and join Living Hope.

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our 6th sermon series of the year: The Heart of Living Hope Pursues

Title: Humble Authenticity | Text: Luke 18:9-14

Main Thrust: God is glorious, holy, and worthy of our deepest reverence, delight, and desire. He is not impressed by outward righteousness, but responds to hearts that come before Him in humble authenticity.

- **Challenge people** to pursue God as He is – not merely through outward expressions, but with a sincere and surrendered heart.
- **Encourage people** to identify with the tax collector, recognizing their need for mercy rather than trusting in their own righteousness.
- **Teach people** how to approach God with humble authenticity—confessing sin, depending fully on His grace, and trusting in His mercy.
- **Help people** see that humility is not thinking less of ourselves. We are worthy of the blood of Jesus. In humility we can recognize our sinfulness and our deep need for the redeeming love of God in Jesus Christ and pursue authenticity.
