DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that Living Hope would be full of zeal to serve Christ and bear witness to Him in our community.

Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord. — Romans 12:11

MONDAY: Global Impact: Burnham Family serving in England.

- Pray for Will and Hudson as they travel. Will is helping lead a training with European church planters from Italy, Germany, the UK, Czech Republic, New Zealand, and Portugal!
- Pray for Danny, Asim, and Yohanna. They're leading a network of churches across Europe. Most of these churches are among former Muslim refugees. Pray for wisdom, discernment, and vision as they lead in a unique time. We believe God has brought the nations into Europe to help revitalize the global Church.
- Pray for Laura as she finishes another year of homeschool with Hunter and Hudson. Pray for the boys to finish well.
- Pray for a new work among Iranians in Germany. God is moving through an Iranian family that came to faith last year and has already led 6 other Iranian households to faith and baptized them. Pray as these new believers form into small churches in these villages spread across southern Germany.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Continue to ask God to bless Living Hope as we prepare to move to four services in August.

SATURDAY: Pray as we continue our 6th sermon series of the year: **The Heart of Living Hope Pursues**

Title: Grateful Generosity | Text: Matthew 20:1-16

Main Thrust: God sovereignly and graciously gives according to His goodness, not our merit. As recipients of His grace, we are freed to live and give with grateful generosity, without comparison or complaint.

- **Challenge people** to see themselves as called into God's vineyard and created for and entrusted with a Kingdom assignment.
- **Encourage people** to pursue what God has given them, trusting His provision and resisting the temptation to compare their calling or blessings with others.
- **Teach people** how our generosity is to flow from God's generosity to us. We give freely because we have freely received.

- **Help people** see the joy of serving in God's Kingdom, resting in His provision, and cultivating a life marked by contentment and generous giving.
