DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Title: Our Refuge and Strength | Text: Psalm 46

- **Challenge people** - Challenge people to run to the Lord, rather than away from Him, when life is hard.
- **Encourage people** – Encourage people by reminding them that God is our refuge, strength, help, fortress, and God. He is with us. Therefore, we have no need to fear.
- **Teach people** – Teach people that our confidence comes because of our knowledge of God's presence.
- **Help people** – Help people understand that faith is not the absence of fear, but trust and obedience despite it.
