Our kids ministry classes will be 1 and 2-hour experiences designed to help kids grow in their faith through engaging discipleship, worship, scripture memorization, hands-on activities, and meaningful connection with peers and adults. Each gathering creates a safe, fun, and Christ-centered environment where children can build friendships, learn God's Word, and develop a lasting relationship with Jesus. We would love for children to join us for the entire 2-hour experience but are also welcome either hour (9:00, 10:15).



On Sunday mornings, our students engage in fellowship, large group teaching, and small group discussion that is focused on our IDENTITY in Christ and how to live that out. Each student will be placed in a small group with peers and trusted volunteer leaders who will intentionally help them to understand and apply the scriptures that we're teaching.
