DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

MONDAY: Global Partners – The Burnhams, serving in Europe

- Pray for a new outreach to Kurds and Iranians in Armenia. We have a new team that is running across Europe engaging Unreached Unengaged People Groups. Pray for Ben and Savannah as they engage these Muslim peoples with the Gospel.
- Pray for our family as we travel to the U.S. this summer for college visits! Hunter is entering his senior year of high school and decisions for his future are starting now!

WEDNESDAY: 10:2 Focus

- Pray for God to bless the worship ministry and preachers as they lead in 4 services each Sunday.
- Pray for God to cause LH to grow in maturity, commitment, and hope.

SATURDAY: Pray as we begin our 8th Sermon Series of the year: **The Heart of Remembers**. In this series, we will look at three important stories in the OT that demonstrate how the Gospel enables believers to remember rightly so that they can respond faithfully and live in accordance with God's will.

Title: Sin Is Serious | Text: 2 Sam 12:1-5; Psalm 51

Main Thrust: Remember that sin is serious. Sin will deceive us into believing lies about ourselves, our actions, and God. When we allow those lies to shape our understanding, destruction follows. We must allow God's Word to convict us and God's people to lovingly remind us of what is true.

- **Challenge people** to refuse the false comfort of lies that excuse sin, minimize its consequences, or convince them that it is not a serious matter.
- **Encourage people** to give God's Word and God's people permission to speak truth clearly, convictingly, and courageously into their lives.
- **Teach people** how to remember what is true and then repent rightly.

- **Help people** see that while the truth can be painful, it is also liberating. Remembering the seriousness of sin is the pathway to spiritual health and restoration.
