Red & Green Blocks

Week 1 - God saves Noah - Genesis 6-9

Foundational truth: God is good.

Review Questions. You can start with "tell me what you learned today".

- ☐ Why did God tell Noah to build an ark? (God was going to flood the earth.)
- ☐ Why of all the people in the world did God save Noah and his family? (God Is Good and saw that Noah loved him. Noah wasn't perfect but Noah loved God and did his best to be obedient to God.)
- ☐ Who was in the ark? (Noah, his family, and two of each kind of animal)
- ☐ What happened to the people who were not on the ark? (They died in the flood; they were sinful and didn't want to turn away from their sin.)
- ☐ What did God promise Noah after the flood? He would never destroy the earth again with a flood.)
- ☐ What did God give us to remind us of this promise? (God gave us a rainbow. God Is Good; He keeps all of His promises.)

Week 2 - God scatters the nations - Genesis 11:1-9

Foundational truth: God is in charge of everything.

Review Questions. You can start with "tell me what you learned today".

- ☐ When Noah and his family got off the ark, what did Noah's sons do? (They spread out all over the world and settled in different places.)
- ☐ One of Noah's sons settled in a place called Shinar. The people there decided to build a big city with a tall tower. Why? (To stay in one place and make themselves look important and powerful; to be special and close to God)
- ☐ When God saw how the people were building the tower to make themselves look important and powerful, what did He do? (He made them all speak in different languages so that they could not understand each other.)
- ☐ Did they continue building the tower? (No)
- ☐ After God confused their languages there, what was Shinar called? (Babel)
- ☐ Where did the people go next? (All over the world like God wanted)

Week 3 - God's promise to Abraham - Genesis 15, 17-18, 21

Foundational truth: The Church is God's family.

Review Questions. You can start with "tell me what you learned today".

- ❑ Did God give Abraham and Sarah a son? (Yes, because God always keeps His promises.)
- ❑ What was their son's name? (Isaac)
- ❑ Today everyone who loves and trusts Jesus is a part of God's family. What is this family called? (The Church!)
- ❑ Let's say our foundational truth together: "The Church Is God's Family!"

Week 4 - God rescues Isaac - Genesis 21-22

Foundational truth: God is in charge of everything.

Review Questions. You can start with "tell me what you learned today".

- ❑ Did God give Abraham and Sarah a son? (Yes, because God always keeps His promises.)
- ❑ What was their son's name? (Isaac)
- ❑ What did God ask Abraham to do with Isaac? (God asked Abraham to sacrifice Isaac and give Isaac back to God.)
- ❑ Did Abraham obey? (Yes, Abraham did obey because he loved and trusted God.)
- ❑ What happened right before Abraham was about to kill Isaac? (Abraham heard a voice that told him not to kill his son, Isaac.)
- ❑ How do we know that God can keep His promises? (Because God Is in Charge of Everything)
- ❑ Let's say our foundational truth together: "God Is in Charge of Everything!"
