DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Title: Delight in God’s Mysterious Work | Text: Mark 4:26-29

Main Thrust: While the process of growth is often hidden and mysterious, God is always at work, bringing His people to maturity and fruitfulness in His perfect time.

- **Challenge people** to embrace both their responsibility and their limitations. We are called to faithfully plant and water, but only God can give the growth.
- **Encourage people** to believe that it is God’s will that His children be fruit-bearing disciples.
- **Teach people** how to recognize and celebrate the normal progression of spiritual growth—from the blade, to the ear, to the full grain in the ear—without expecting instant maturity.
- **Help people** patiently trust God’s timing, even when His work is unseen, knowing that He is faithfully accomplishing His purposes.
